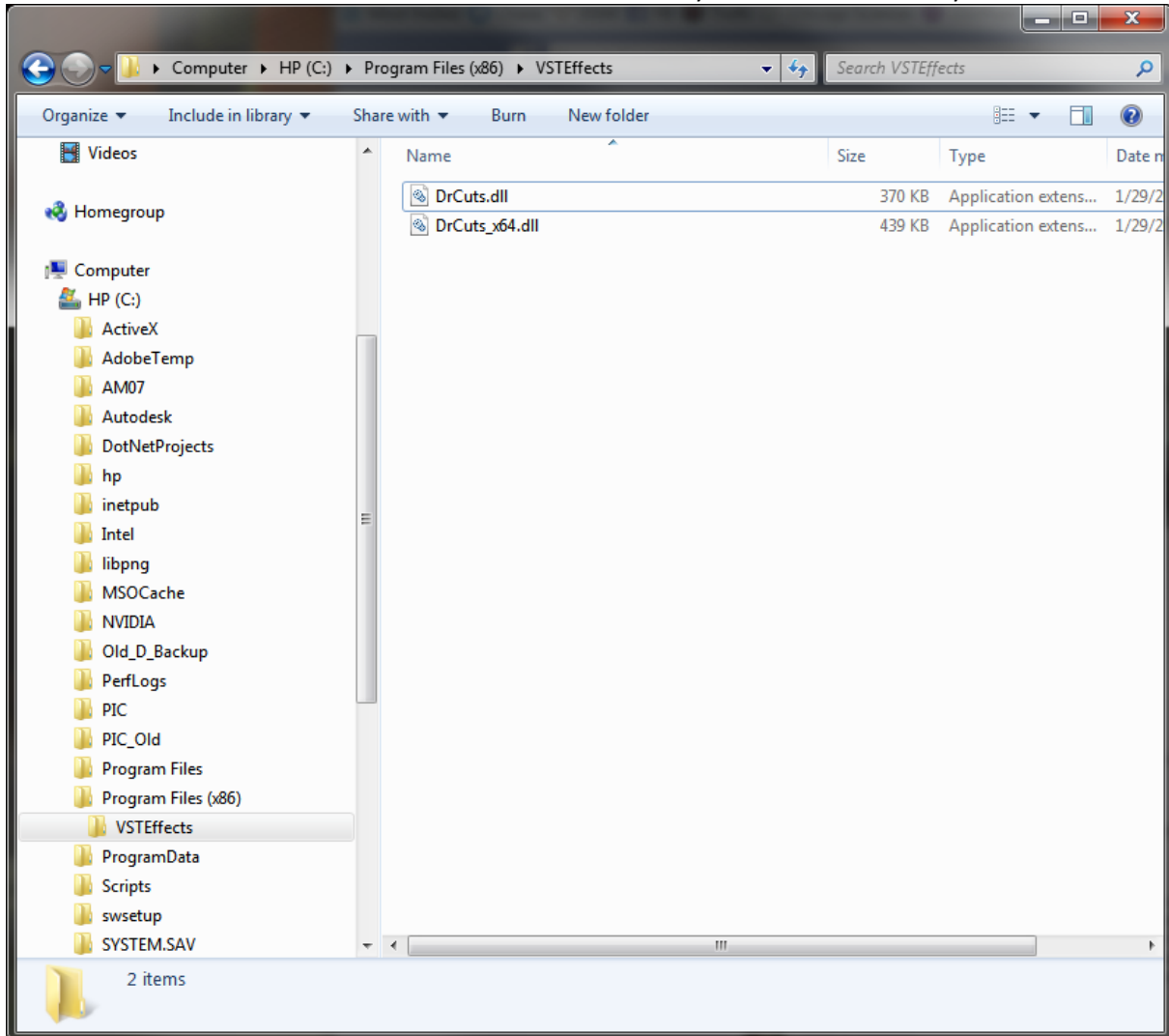
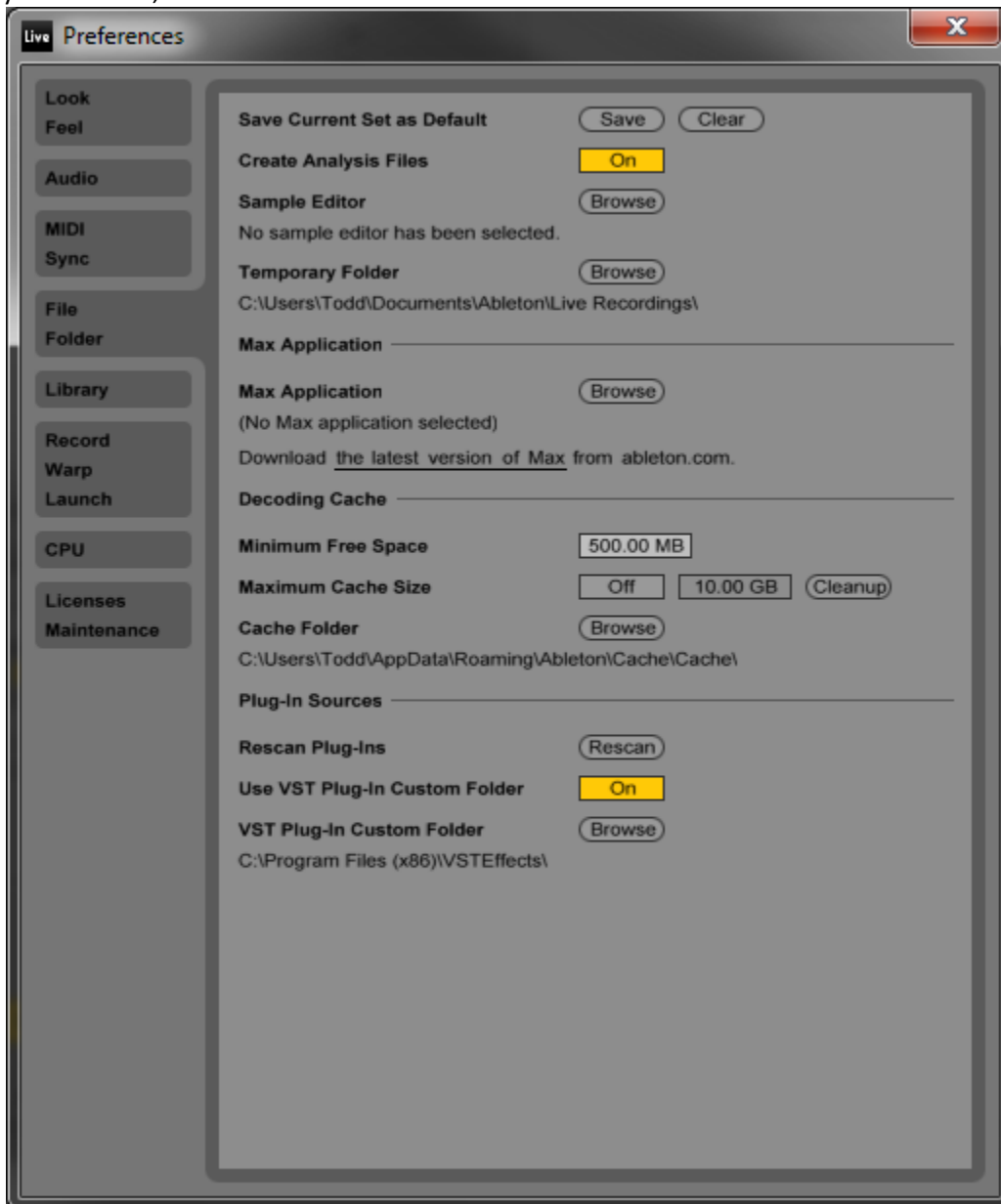


Dr. Cuts Vinyl Mastering VST Setup Ableton 9 on Windows

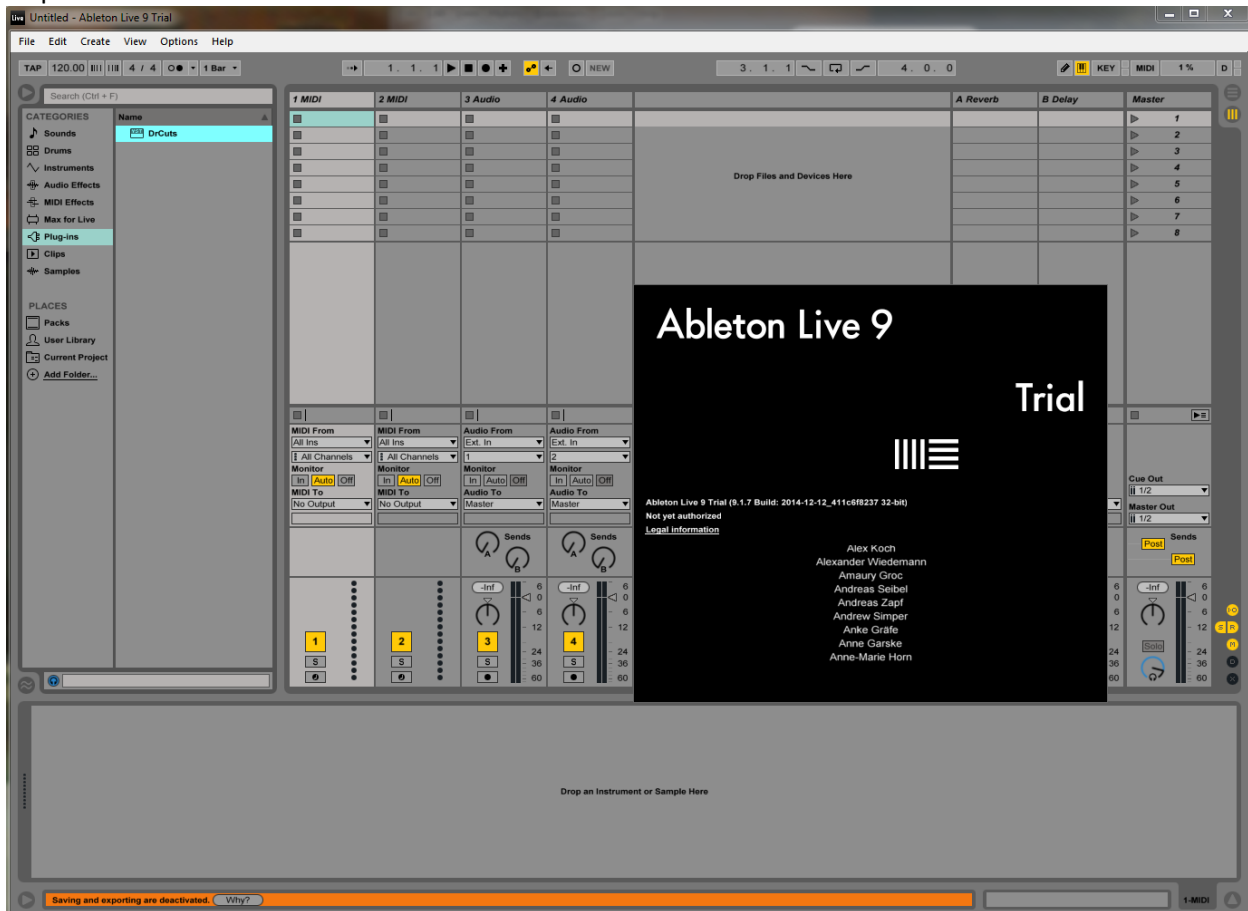
You need to place the VST in a folder accessible from your software. In windows this must be a folder contained within C:\Programs Files (x86). Mine is C:\Program Files (x86)\VSTEffects. Unzip both the 32 bit and the 64 bit versions into this folder. It won't matter if you have both and only use one.



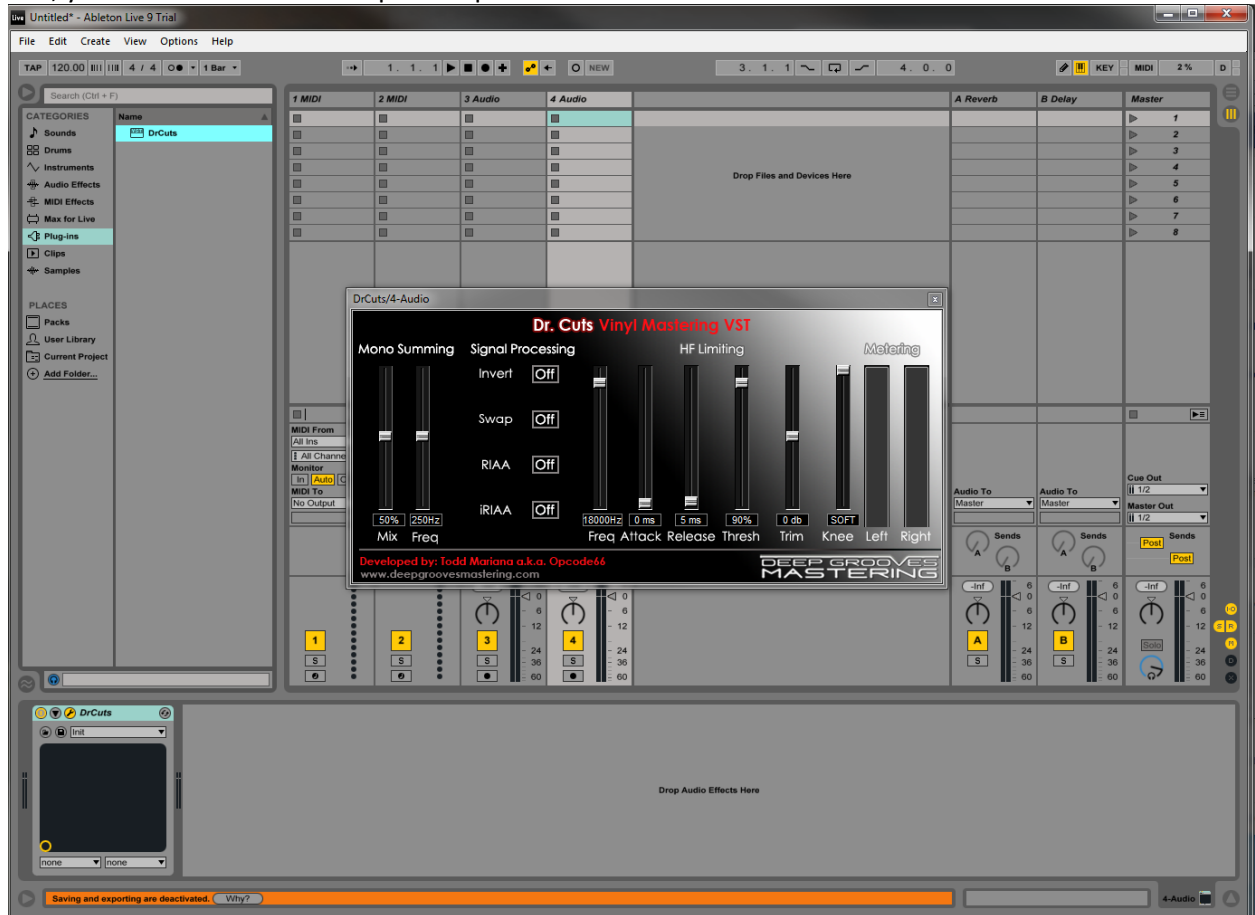
Then, in Ableton, you need to open the Preferences window via the Options menu item. Now click on File Folder tab on the left. On the File Folder screen, click on the browse button to select the folder where you placed Dr. Cuts. Then, be sure that the Use VST Plug-in Custom Folder button says On and is yellow. Now, click Rescan.




You can see here that I'm running Ableton 9 and that you can now select DrCuts from the Plug-ins menu strip on the left.



And, you can see here that I've pulled up the effect's visual editor.
